(Please read)

1 - Children under 12 not permitted in the dance area for safety reasons.

- 2 - Never come onto the dance floor carrying beverages or lighted cigarettes.
- 3 - Never walk through a line of dancers to cross the floor - always walk around the floor or wait.
- 4 - No one is guaranteed a specific place on the floor. First come first served.
- 5 - If possible start another line rather than join one which will crowd the existing dancers
- 6 - Remember the floor is for everyone. Try to leave enough room for the other dancers.
- 7 - If the floor is crowded, take small steps; enjoy the company, but watch for collisions.
- 8 - If you should bump into someone, it is customary to apologize whether it is your fault or not....

NOTE:

9 - If chatting, keep the volume low enough as to not disrupt the class.

- 10 - When dancing near beginners - be mindful and courteous and don't show off.
- 11 - Remember **everyone** was once a beginner. If you know the dance, do try to be Helpful to newcomers.
- 12 - Don't be tempted to stop during a dance to teach; especially if there is no room.

And finally, keep your head up, keep smiling and enjoy yourselves.
